

LMI, Inc. Privacy Policy

LMI, Inc. is a private investigative company that specializes in providing background investigations and trial preparation assistance to attorneys. We provide information to our clients that sometimes involves consumer reports which may contain criminal records, financial information, and personal information such as dates of birth and addresses. LMI, Inc. takes the privacy and security of personal information very seriously. Please take a moment to review our Privacy Policy below and contact us if you have any questions.

ACCOUNTABILITY

LMI, Inc. will be responsible for all personal information under our control. We have designated two individuals, CEO Linda Montgomery, and Administrative Manager Julie West, to insure compliance with our privacy policy and procedures.

Upon receiving an inquiry, Ms. Montgomery or Ms. West will respond to you within 30 days.

It is LMI's commitment to:

- Protect personal information
- Train and educate our staff
- Develop information which explains these procedures to the public and our clients

When we use third parties to process personal information, we will use reasonable means to ensure that all third party transferring of personal information is afforded a comparable level of protection to that which LMI maintains.

CONSENT

We will obtain the appropriate consent from individuals for collection, use or disclosure of personal information, except where the law provides an exception. We may obtain express consent for the collection, user disclosure of personal information, or when we determine that consent has been implied by the circumstances.

Express consent is specific authorization given by the individual to LMI, Inc., either orally or in writing. Implied consent is when LMI, Inc. has not received a specific consent but the circumstances allow us to collect, use, or disclose personal information.

LIMITING COLLECTION

The personal information that we collect will be limited to that which is necessary for purposes we have identified. We will only collect personal information for specific, legitimate purposes. We will not collect personal information indiscriminately. We will only collect information by fair and lawful means and not by misleading or deceiving individuals about the purpose for which the information is being collected. Our policies and procedures relating to the limitations on collection of personal information will be regularly communicated to our investigators who deal with collection, use and disclosure of personal information.

We request information from you on our order form. To buy from us, you must provide contact information (name and billing address) and financial information (credit card number and expiration date). This information is used for billing purposes and to fill your orders. If we have trouble processing an order, we will use this information to contact you.

We share aggregated demographic information with our partners and advertisers. This is not linked to any personal information that can identify any individual person.

We partner with another party to provide specific services. When the user signs up for these services, we will share names, or other contact information that is necessary for the third party to provide these services. These parties are not allowed to use personally identifiable information except for the purpose of providing these services.

RETENTION OF DATA

Personal information that is no longer required to fulfill identified purposes or legal requirements will be destroyed, erased, or made anonymous.

COOKIES

SECURITY
